Join our members and their guests on a two-day field trip to explore fur trading posts of northern Minnesota and Canada from the 18th century for a spectacular Price of \$129.

Friday, July 11th

- 10:45 a.m.** Parking and bus pick up - DECC/Duluth (\$4 for parking)
- 11:00 a.m.** Coach bus departs – Travel on scenic Highway 61 along Lake Superior’s north shore featuring scenic waterfalls and overlooks.
- 2:30 p.m.** Arrive Grand Marais – tour the Cook County History Museum, walk the waterfront to the lighthouse or find a spot to enjoy a treat.
- 4:30 p.m.** Arrive Grand Portage National Monument – tour a restored fur trading post which tells the story of fur trading more than 200 years ago.
- 5:30 p.m.** Arrive Grand Portage Lodge and Casino - tour package is for double occupancy - lodge has a full service restaurant, lounge, indoor pool, sauna and casino. Dinner with group is included in package.
- 6: 30 p.m.** Social hour and dinner
- 8:00 p.m.** Entertainment Slide Show

Saturday, July 12th

- 7:30 a.m.** Coach bus departs to take us into Canada’s vast wilderness
- 9:00 a.m.** (Canadian Eastern Time) – When crossing the Canadian border, each passenger must have a valid ID and proof of citizenship (notarized copy of birth or citizen certificate)
- 10:00 a.m.** Arrive Founders’ Museum and Pioneer Village – tour a 1900’s village portraying the lives of early settlers.
- Noon** Lunch at Founders’ Museum
- 1:00 p.m.** Coach bus departs museum to go to Fort William Historic Park
- 1:30 p.m.** Arrive Fort William Historic Park – meet costumed characters of the Canadian fur trade from the early 1800’s, explore the native camp, Great Hall, fur stores and the farm.
- 3:30 p.m.** Depart Fort William Historic Park
- 3:00 p.m.** (United States Central Time) – When crossing the American border, each passenger must have a valid ID and proof of citizenship (notarized copy of birth or citizen certificate).
- 4:00 p.m.** Arrive Grand Marais – 1 hour stretch stop for you to do at your pleasure –
- 5:00 p.m.** Coach bus departs for Duluth, Minnesota
- 7:00 p.m.** Arrive DECC parking lot
